

ORDINANCE NO. 340

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILESBERG, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUIRING THE REMOVAL OF TEMPORARY SIGNS AND REGULATING THE USE OF TEMPORARY COMMERCIAL SIGNS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the authority of the Council of the Borough of Milesburg, Centre County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE - DEFINITIONS

- A. **Temporary sign** - shall mean any sign, flyer, poster, notice, or bulletin posted, hung, placed, erected or otherwise displayed to advertise a specific event or pertaining to a specific event (not including a Temporary Commercial Sign). Such signs include, but are not limited to, legal notices and signs advertising or pertaining to yard sales, charity events, and/or elections.
- B. **Temporary Commercial Sign** - shall mean any non-permanent sign, flyer, poster, notice or bulletin posted, hung, placed, erected, or otherwise displayed on the outside of any home occupation, business or commercial establishment to advertise any product, service, sale or event pertaining to the business or commercial establishment. Interior signs shall not be regulated as temporary commercial signs.

SECTION TWO - REMOVAL OF TEMPORARY SIGNS

Any individual, group, corporation, or other entity posting or erecting a temporary sign within the boundaries of the Borough of Milesburg must remove said temporary sign and dispose of same by 12:00 o'clock noon of the day after the termination of the event to which the temporary sign pertains.

SECTION THREE - USE OF TEMPORARY COMMERCIAL SIGNS

Any individual, business or commercial establishment posting, hanging, placing, erecting, or otherwise displaying a temporary commercial sign must adhere to the following restrictions:

- A. Any home occupation, business or commercial establishment may display no more than two (2) temporary commercial signs, during business hours only, and any such signs shall not be displayed during any non-business hours.

- B. All temporary commercial signs shall be posted, hung, placed, erected, or otherwise displayed in a manner that does not block pedestrian or motor vehicle traffic, or otherwise impede sight lines for pedestrian or motor vehicle traffic.

SECTION FOUR - PENALTY

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50.00 plus prosecution costs and reasonable attorney's fees.

SECTION FIVE - ENFORCEMENT


The Code Enforcement Officer of the Borough is hereby, authorized to act on behalf of the Borough and enforce this Ordinance.

SECTION SIX - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.


