

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ON BEHALF OF MILESBERG BOROUGH,
ALL THAT PORTION OF EAGLE STREET RUNNING IN A NORTH-
EASTERLY DIRECTION FROM MILL STREET TO CENTRE STREET,
TO BE USED AS PUBLIC ROADS OF SAID BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the right of way hereinafter described has been
dedicated to the Borough of Milesburg and used by the public and
maintained by the Borough of Milesburg for a period in excess of
twenty-one years.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the
Borough of Milesburg, Centre County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby
enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION ONE: All that right of way known as Eagle Street
running in a northeasterly direction from Mill Street to Centre
Street consisting of a length of 400 feet and a width of 20 feet,
is hereby adopted and accepted as a public road and street of the
Borough of Milesburg.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Borough Solicitor for
Milesburg Borough be authorized and directed to file a copy of this
Ordinance, together with a draft or a survey of the street herein
described in the office of the Prothonotary of Centre County, and
with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
