

AN ORDINANCE NO. 183 .

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILESBERG, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE COST OF IMPROVING PORTIONS OF HAZEL STREET, AND MILL STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF MILESBERG FOR INSTALLING CURBING BY THE BOROUGH ALONG SAID STREETS ON THE FOOT FRONT ASSESSMENT OF ALL ASSESSABLE PROPERTIES ABUTTING SAID IMPROVEMENT AT THE RATE OF \$1.10 PER FOOT; AND PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF PAYMENT THEREFOR.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Milesburg, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the assessable cost and expense of improving Hazel Street from Catherine Street to Mill Street, and Mill Street from Market Street to 82 feet beyond the intersection of Market Street and Hazel Street by the installation of curbing in accordance with the work and contract in improving the same by Schreffler, Hoy and Smith, is hereby assessed and shall be collected from the owners of the real estate bounding or abutting thereon, by an equal assessment on the footage bounding or abutting as aforesaid, which assessment shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Act of February 1, 1966, P.L. 581.

SECTION 2: That the foot front assessment hereby assessed against the abutting property owners is a \$1.10 per foot front.

SECTION 3: In accordance with Article 1761 of the Act of February 1, 1966, Act No. 581, the Borough Council may make equitable adjustment for corner lots or lots of irregular shape when assessment for full frontage might be unjust.

SECTION 4: That upon completion of the improvement as aforesaid and acceptance thereof by the Borough Council, notice

of the foot front assessment for each abutting property owner shall be given by the Borough Secretary, which notice shall provide that the foot front assessment shall be paid within thirty (30) days after service of the notice of assessment.

SECTION 5: All such assessments shall be paid within one (1) year after notice of the same and upon failure to pay the same at the expiration of the notice, it shall be the duty of the Borough Solicitor to collect the same with interest by filing a lien in accordance with the Municipal Claims Act and collecting the same in the manner authorized therein.

SECTION 6: Pending the collections hereinabove assessed, there is hereby appropriated sufficient unappropriated funds of the Borough of Milesburg to carry on the work of the improvement, to be repaid from the assessments above mentioned.

SECTION 7: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED into an Ordinance of the Borough of Milesburg this 7th day of October, A.D. 1968.
