

ORDINANCE NO. 189

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ON BEHALF OF MILESBERG BOROUGH ALL THAT PORTION OF CENTRE STREET RUNNING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION FROM BALD EAGLE CREEK TO "OLD" U. S. ROUTE 220 TO BE USED AS A PUBLIC ROAD OF SAID BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the right of way hereinafter described has been dedicated to the Borough of Milesburg and used by the public and maintained by the Borough of Milesburg for a period in excess of twenty-one years.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Milesburg, Centre County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION ONE: All that right of way known as Centre Street running in a northerly direction from Bald Eagle Creek to Water Street, also known and designated as "Old" U. S. Route No. 220, consisting of a length of 170.00 feet and a width of 18.00 feet, is hereby adopted and accepted as a public road and street of the Borough of Milesburg.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Borough Solicitor for Milesburg Borough be authorized and directed to file a copy of this Ordinance, together with a draft or a survey of the street herein described in the office of the Prothonotary of Centre County and with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
