AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ON BEHALF OF MILESBERG BOROUGH ALL THAT PORTION OF COMMERCIAL EXTENSION RUNNING IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH COMMERCIAL STREET, A DISTANCE OF 555 FEET, TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH OKLAWAHA STREET TO BE USED AS A PUBLIC ROAD OF SAID BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the right of way hereinafter described has been dedicated to the Borough of Milesburg and used by the public and maintained by the Borough of Milesburg since its dedication for a period in excess of twenty-one (21) years.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Milesburg, Centre County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION ONE: All that right of way known as Commercial Street Extension running in a southerly direction from its intersection with Commercial Street, 555 feet to its intersection with Oklawaha Street, is hereby adopted and accepted as a public road and street of the Borough of Milesburg.

SECTION TWO: Be it further ordained that the Borough Solicitor for Milesburg Borough be authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance, together with a draft or a survey of the street herein described, in the office of the prothonotary of Centre County and with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED as an ordinance of the Borough of Milesburg this 10 day of Sept., 1990.
