

ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ON BEHALF OF MILESBERG BOROUGH THE FOLLOWING STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF: CHURCH STREET EXTENSION, 600 LINEAR FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH CHURCH STREET; OWL STREET, 425 LINEAR FEET EXTENDING FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH CATHERINE STREET TO HAZLE STREET; CANAL STREET, 440 LINEAR FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH CATHERINE STREET TO CENTRE STREET; BRICK STREET, 360 LINEAR FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH HIGH STREET TO SPRING STREET; LION'S STREET, 233 LINEAR FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH SRO144; CREEK STREET, 250 LINEAR FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH GROVE STREET: and DEPOT STREET, 204 LINEAR FEET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH GROVE STREET, TO BE USED AS PUBLIC ROADS OF SAID BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the rights of way hereinafter described have been dedicated to the Borough of Milesburg and used by the public and maintained by the Borough since their dedication for a period in excess of twenty-one (21) years.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Milesburg, Centre County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION ONE: All those certain rights of way as hereinafter set forth are hereby adopted and accepted as public roads and streets of the Borough of Milesburg:

Church St. Ext.	600 L. F.	Church St.
Owl St.	425 L. F.	Catherine St. to Hazle St.
Canal St.	440 L. F.	Catherine St. to Centre St.
Brick St.	360 L. F.	High St. to Spring St.
Lion's St.	233 L. F.	SRO144
Creek St.	250 L. F.	Grove St.
Depot St.	204 L. F.	Grove St.

SECTION TWO: Be it further ordained that the Borough Solicitor for Milesburg Borough be authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance, together with a draft or a survey of the

streets herein described, in the Office of the Prothonotary of Centre County and with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED as an ordinance of the Borough of Milesburg this 9th day of December, 1991.
