

ORDINANCE# 280

AN ORDINANCE, of the Borough of Milesburg, abolishing the keeping of livestock, excluding domestic dogs and cats in the Borough.

Penalty: Any person(s), firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable for every such offense, upon conviction before any District Magistrate to a fine of not less than (\$25.00) nor more than (\$500.00), plus costs. Each day after notification shall constitute a separate offense. After notification you will have 5 days to remove livestock before further action will be taken.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Milesburg, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, on this 12th day of June, 2000.
