

ORDINANCE NO. 301

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILESBERG, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE TIMES WHEN TRASH AND TRASH CONTAINERS ARE PERMITTED TO BE SET OUTSIDE FOR COLLECTION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the authority of the Council of the Borough of Milesburg, Centre County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained pursuant to the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION ONE - PROHIBITION**

No trash, garbage, refuse, or recyclables, or receptacles for same may be placed on or along any sidewalk, curb, public street, alley, right-of-way, or any private property within view of the thoroughfare which fronts such private property earlier than 6:00 p.m. on the day before the day of collection. Trash, refuse, and/or recyclable containers must be removed from the sidewalk, curb, public street, alley, right-of-way, and/or any private property where such containers are visible from the thoroughfare fronting such property no later than 12:00 o'clock noon on the day after collection.

**SECTION TWO - PENALTY**

Violation of this Section shall constitute a summary offense and, upon conviction before a District Justice, may be punished by a fine not to exceed fifty (\$50.00) dollars plus costs of the action and reasonable attorney's fees.

**SECTION THREE - ENFORCEMENT**

The Code Enforcement Officer of the Borough is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the Borough and enforce this Ordinance.

**SECTION FOUR - EFFECTIVE DATE**


This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.


