

ORDINANCE NO. 303

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILESBERG, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUIRING THE REMOVAL OF TEMPORARY SIGNS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the authority of the Council of the Borough of Milesburg, Centre County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE - DEFINITIONS

- A. **Temporary sign** - shall mean any sign, flyer, poster, notice, or bulletin erected or posted to advertise a specific event or pertaining to a specific event. Such signs include, but are not limited to, legal notices and signs advertising or pertaining to yard sales, charity events, and/or elections.

SECTION TWO - REMOVAL OF TEMPORARY SIGNS

Any individual, group, corporation, or other entity posting or erecting a temporary sign within the boundaries of the Borough of Milesburg must remove said temporary sign and dispose of same by 12:00 o'clock noon of the day after the termination of the event to which the temporary sign pertains.

SECTION THREE - PENALTY

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50.00 plus prosecution costs and reasonable attorney's fees.

SECTION FOUR - ENFORCEMENT


The Code Enforcement Officer of the Borough is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the Borough and enforce this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.




