Riff-Raff/Bulk Item Collection on October 12th, 2019:
Friday, October 11 – Items are to be put at curbside, **but not before 4:00 pm.**
Saturday, October 12 – Items being picked up must be at curbside by 7:00 am.

Halloween Trick-or-Treat will be held on October 31st from 6 – 8 pm.

Brush Collection - Brush collection is on the last Monday of the month, see website. Christmas trees pick up 01/27/2020.

Park Rentals - Call the Borough Office @ (814) 355-3583. Renting guarantees you a pavilion, water and electricity.

Grass and leaves are not to be blown onto the streets as they clog the storm drains.

Burning Ordinance – No burning of garbage, brush or leaves within the Borough. Only friendship fires are allowed.

Permits - If you need a building, zoning, driveway paving, or rental permit, they are now issued by **Penns Valley Code Enforcement Agency** at (814) 349-8177, or check the Borough website.

Snow removal guidelines per Ordinance 348 state that your car needs to be moved off the street if we have 4 or more inches or a snow emergency. Parking is available at the rear parking lot of Citizens Hook and Ladder Fire Company on Catherine Street.

Public sidewalks are to be cleared no later than 24 hours after the snow stops per Ordinance 255.

Rental Code Notice – Under Rental Code Ordinance #358, any rental for human habitation for any duration requires obtaining a rental permit from Penns Valley Code.
