**Leaf collection** for the residents of Milesburg Borough will be done on the following dates:

**October 19, 26 November 2, 9, & 16.**

**Christmas tree pickup – January 25, 2021**

**Brush collection** will be the last Monday of each month. Please have all brush at the curb facing in the same direction with tree limbs no larger than 5 inches in diameter. **Remove other refuse and animal waste from brush piles.** This service can only be provided to residents of Milesburg Borough. If you live in one of the adjacent municipalities, contact your municipal office to ask about their brush and leaf collection program.

**Snow removal guidelines** - As per Ordinance 255, property owners and tenants are responsible to clear snow and ice from public walks within 24 hours of the occurrence.

**Permits** – If you need a building, zoning, driveway paving, or rental permit, they are now issued by Penns Valley Code Enforcement Agency at (814) 349-8177 or check the Borough website.

**Park Rentals** – Call the Borough Office (814) 355-3583. Renting guarantees you a pavilion, water and electricity.

**Rental Code Notice:** Under Rental Code Ordinance #358, any rental for human habitation for any duration requires obtaining a rental permit from Penns Valley Code.

**Ordinance #348** – Not permitted at anytime to shovel or plow snow and/or ice; or no placing grass clippings, leaves, construction material, demolition material or other objects onto any street or alley of Milesburg Borough.

**Ordinance #348** – Hazel Street on both sides no parking for 24 hours after a snow fall of 4" or more.
