### **Borough Announcements**

Brush collection will be the last Monday of each month. Please have all brush at the curb facing in the same direction with tree limbs no larger than 5 inches in diameter. *Remove other refuse and animal waste from brush piles*. This service can only be provided to residents of Milesburg Borough. If you live in one of the adjacent municipalities, contact your municipal office to ask about their brush and leaf collection program.

**Ordinance 301** -.Trash cans are not to be placed on or along sidewalks, curbs, public street, alley, right- of-way or private property no earlier than 6:00 p.m. on the day before the day of trash collection. Once collection has been made, trash, refuse, recycle containers must be removed by noon on the day after collection.

**Rental Code Notice**: Under Rental Code Ordinance #358, any rental for human habitation for any duration requires obtaining a rental permit from Penns Valley Code. 814-349-8177

When walking your dog in Milesburg Borough, it must be on a leash as per the State Dog Law. When walking your pet, please pick up all feces. If you see someone not cleaning up after their pet, call Keith Rupert @ 814- 933-8097 for code enforcement.

**Ordinance #348** – Not permitted at anytime to shovel or plow snow and/or ice; or no placing grass clippings, leaves, construction material, demolition material or other objects onto any street or alley of Milesburg Borough.

**Ordinance #356** – All cats are to be kept on your property, no running at large.

**Burning Ordinance** – No burning of garbage, brush or leaves within the borough. Only friendship fires are allowed.

**Nuisance Ordinance** – Prohibit - Accumulation of refuse, debris, garbage and rubbish, junk vehicles, mowers, tractors, trailers, motor homes, vehicle parts, storage of scraps, recyclables, grass, and weeds and etc. No grass, weeds, vegetation over 6 inches tall. No trees and vegetation encroaching upon public thoroughfare. Conditions attracting rats and vermin. Barking dogs. The Ordinance can be viewed in its entirety by visiting the website.
